List of major changes in Part VIII from 2017 edition

1.1.1 Revised

Rules for the construction and classification of aluminum vessels 2017 have been partly amended as follows:

Chapter 1 General

Paragraph 1.1.1 has been amended as follows:

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1.1.1 In general, the aluminum light structure crafts which are capable of maximum speed as specified in 1.1.3 of Part II of the Rules and not to proceed in the course of their voyage more than the time as specified in 1.2.1(a) or 1.2.1(b) of Part II from a place of refuge, are to comply with Chapter 4, Chapter 7 and Chapter 8 of the Rules for the Construction and Classification of High-Speed Craft as appropriate, the aluminum passenger ships and the aluminum cargo ships are to be in accordance with Part IX of the "Rules for the Construction and Classification of Steel Ships." Rules for Steel Ships.

1.1.2 The aluminum cargo ships below 500 gross tonnage or ships of restricted or special services or ships not propelled by mechanical means, the requirements in this Part may be modified to the satisfaction of the Society.



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
